The above named overall topics of the seminar set the frame within which specific project proposal can be addressed.


## **Working language**

PAD as hosting NA will cover hosting costs (accommodation, food, conference arrangements). The sending NA will pay the travel costs of the participants from home to the venue.


## Travel information
